NOTES: Kahuku is coming off a first-round come-from-behind win over BIIF champion Hilo, 20-10. Punahou is coming off a first-round bye and is well rested, haven't played a game in three weeks since 10/24 versus Saint Louis.

Kapaa (7-0) vs. #2 Iolani (6-3)

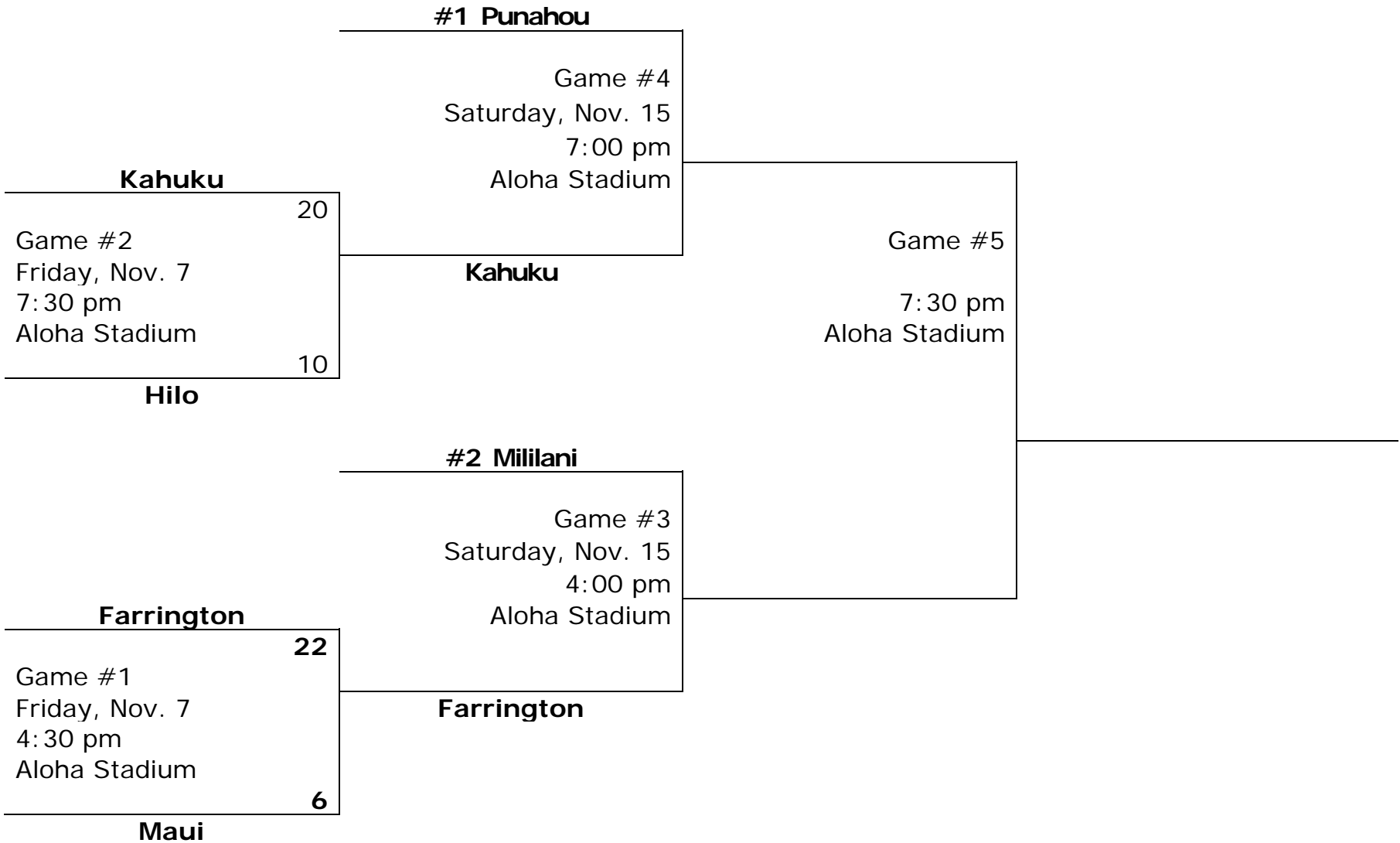
NOTES: KIF champion Kapaa is making its second state tournament appearance. Iolani is making their 10<sup>th</sup> straight DII state tournament appearance.

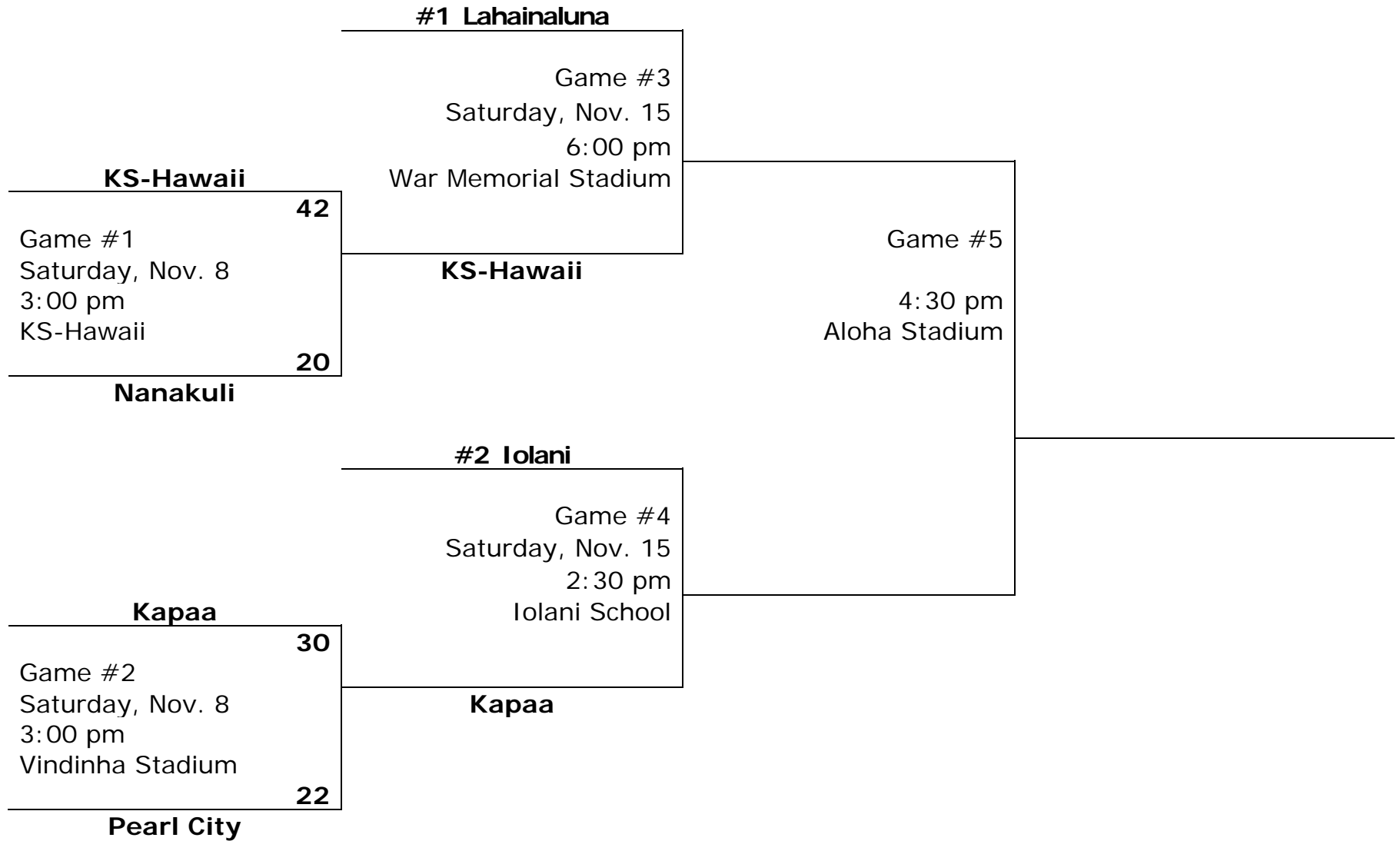
