Four teams remain as they vie for state championship crowns in two divisions in the 2014 First Hawaiian Bank/HHSAA Football State Championships, Friday, Nov. 21, 2014, at Aloha Stadium. Kickoff for the Division II championship is slated for 4:30 p.m., with the Division I championship to follow at 7:30 p.m.

MATCH-UP NOTES:

Division I

#2 Mililani (12-0) vs. #1 Punahou (8-0)

#2 Mililani Trojans, the OIA Red Division champion, is making its seventh HHSAA state tournament appearance, and second championship game. The Trojans are looking for their first Division I state championship.

#1 Punahou Buffanblu, the ILH Division I champion, is making its sixth appearance in the HHSAA tournament, and reached the championship game all six of those times. Mililani and Punahou will face each other for a second time to claim the 2014 First Hawaiian Bank/HHSAA Division I Football Championship.

Highlights – Senior Kanawai Noa needs 41 yards to pass 2000 St. Louis graduate Gerald Welch's 3,490 yards.

#2 Iolani (7-3-0) vs. #1 Lahainaluna (10-0-0)

ILH champion, #2 Iolani is looking to take their eighth state Division II title, is making its tenth Division II overall state tournament appearance under Coach Wendell Look.
