Beginning Monday, Nov. 13, First Hawaiian Bank will be selling specially discounted \$10 general admission tickets at all Oahu branches, in addition to the Lahaina and Kahana branches on Maui; and the Hilo, Waiakea, Kona and Kealahou branches on the Big Island. Trophy presentation for the Division II championship will take place during the Division I championship game's 1st quarter/2nd quarter break in the north endzone. The Division I trophy presentation will take place during the Division I-Open 1st quarter/2nd quarter break in the north endzone.

There is a media photo opportunity so please be ready as the break nears as the quarter intermission is only two minutes in length. All teams are expected to participate in the trophy presentation.

For the Division I-Open championship, media interviews may take place on the field following the post-game team handshake and trophy presentation.

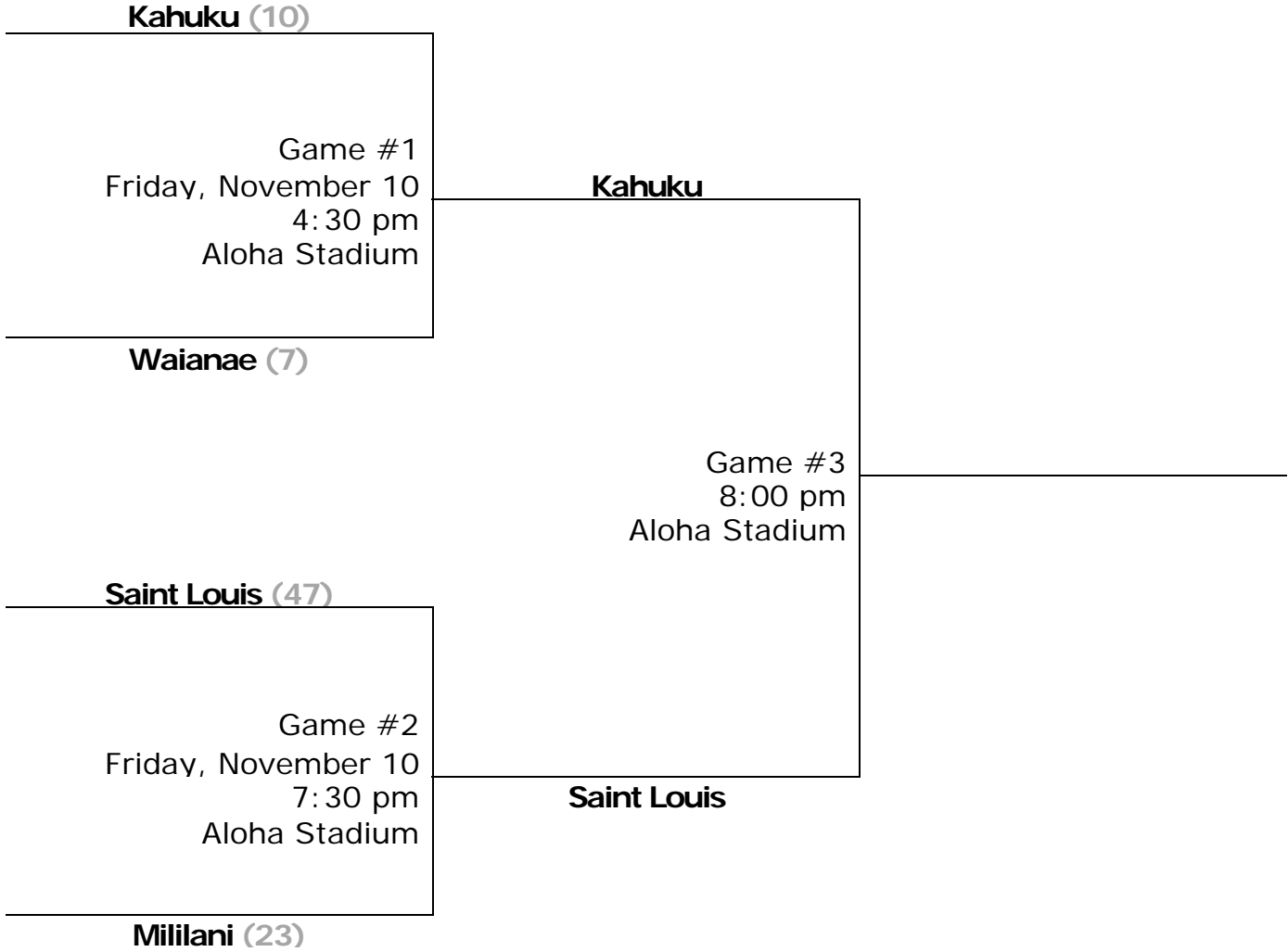

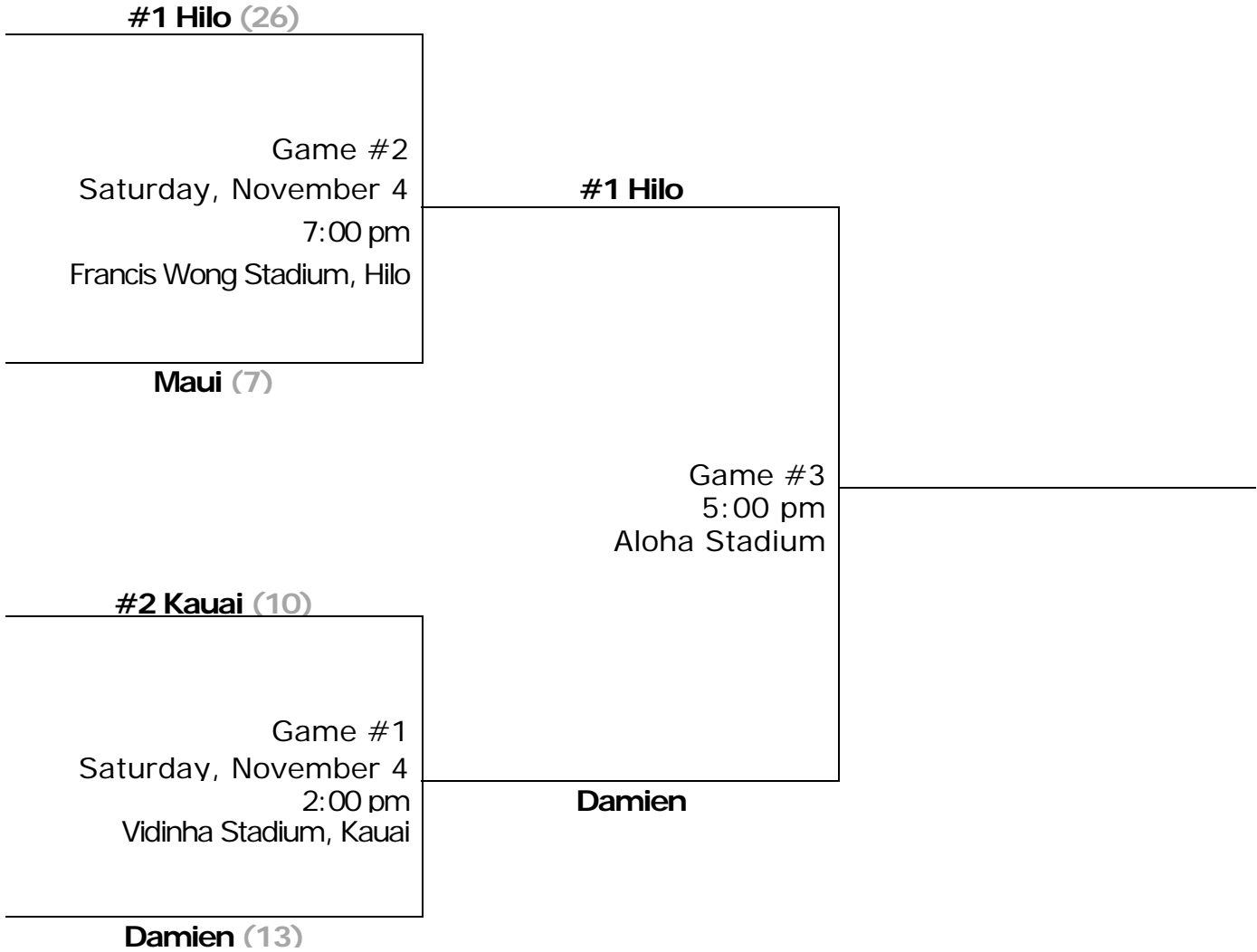

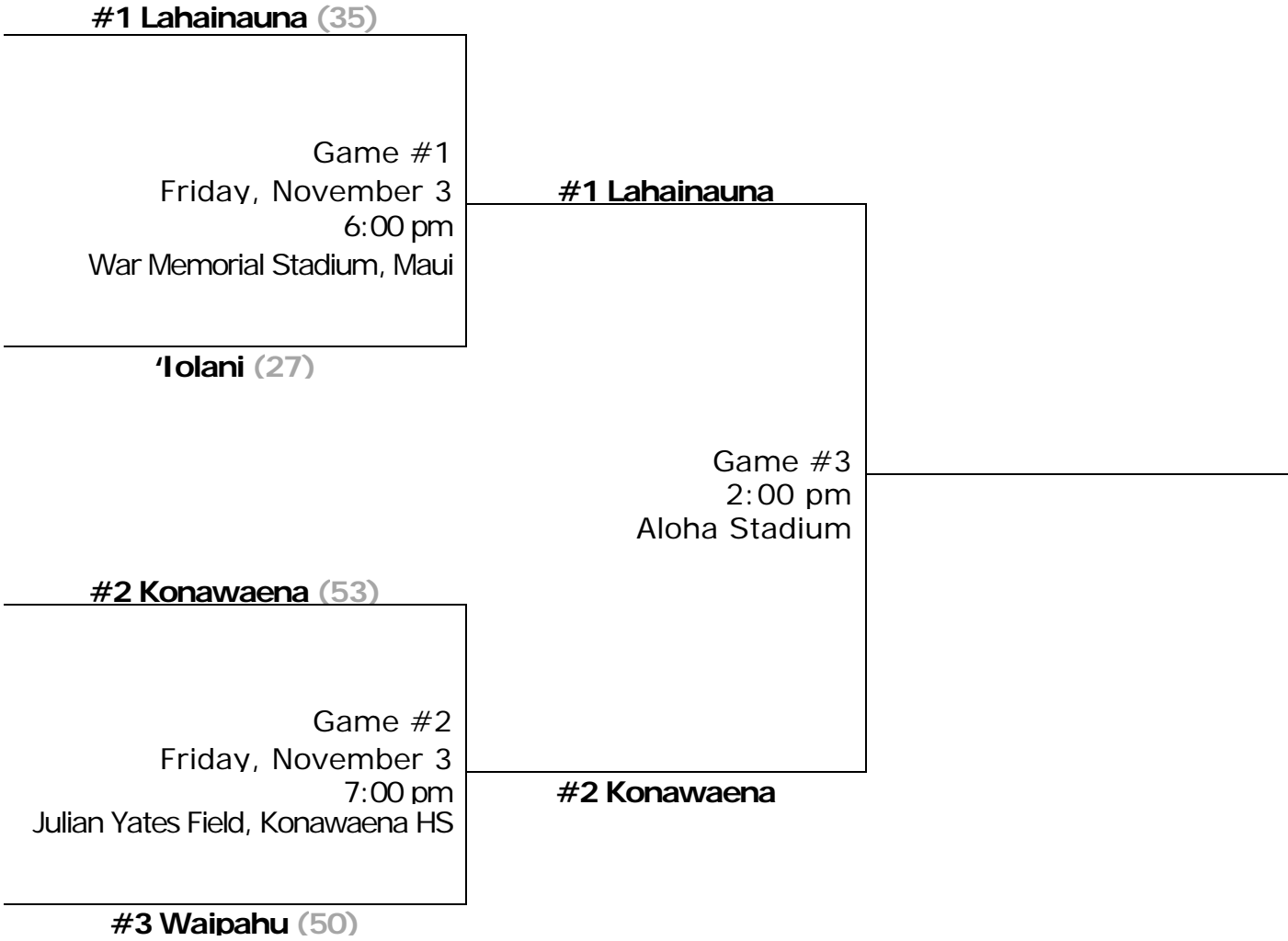
