

Preliminary Tournament Information 2007

Special ROTC Match requires cadet, notify stat office before moving to the firing line.

CBI must be used to indicate your rifle is clear and safe in addition to open bolt and open pump handle. See Rule 2.2 for description of CBI.

When transporting an uncased rifle, the CBI must be inserted and the muzzle must point up and be above head level.

Trigger finger must remain outside the trigger guard until lining up on target sheet.

When loading in the standing position, pellets must be loaded from a height not below knee height of the shooter.

When loading in any position, but especially in kneeling, the muzzle must be pointed down range in the direction of the target frames. Muzzle must not point up at the ceiling or sky. At the Neal Blaisdell Exhibition Hall, the muzzle should not point above the target frames. Get accustomed to doing this by practicing this before the state tournament.

Though you have a total of 4 sighter bulls, you may only use one set of two on the first target card you shoot.

Refer to Rule 7.4 Moving Equipment to & from the Line.

Target identification will consist only of your sticker at the top right corner of the each target sheet. No other marking may be on your targets.

Stage one is the left target sheet while stage two is the right sheet.

Your target labels are printed with the positions, prone, kneeling, & standing. Be sure to use the correct label for each position.

If error is discovered prior before the targets are sent to the stat office, have range officer correct your target.

Equipment check will be performed at check in on the morning of the tournament beginning at 7am. Competitor's target stickers and start numbers will be issued upon completion of equipment check.
